Cavit Pinot Grigio (Italy) **34.00**

A clear, dry white wine with a pale straw color, characteristic mellow aromas and smooth, delicate, fresh and well-balanced flavor.

Terlato Pinot Grigio (Friuli, Italy) **45.00**

Clean, crisp and elegant with an inviting perfume.

Robert Mondavi Napa Sauvignon Blanc (Napa Valley, California) **38.00**

Aromas of lemon, grapefruit, and pear with a hint of grass.

Wairau River Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, New Zealand) **45.00**

Bursting with intense tropical fruit, peach, lemon, grapefruit and passionfruit.

Maddalena Chardonnay (Monterey, California) **36.00**

Ripe fruit aromas with balanced acidity and a long, complex finish

Markham Chardonnay (Napa Valley, California) **40.00**

Packed with lots of bright tropical fruit aromas plus an interesting layer of toasty spice.

Sanford Chardonnay (California) **43.00**

Bright tropical fruit notes with underlying minerality.

Chateau Ste Michelle Riesling (Washington) **35.00**

Bright and jazzy with lively pear and floral aromas and flavors.

Prisoner Red Blend (California)

82.00

The Wine features enticing aromas of bing cherry, espresso and roasted fig. Persistent flavors of ripe raspberry, pomegranate and wild berry linger harmoniously for a smooth and luscious finish.

Brassfield Eruption Malbec Blend (Lake County, California)

40.00

Rich blackberry, raspberry and plum notes flowing into ripe fruit, reminiscent to blueberry pie balanced with baking spices.

Mon Frere Pinot Noir (California)

36.00

Enticing aromas of cheery, raspberry and plum, and a faint violet hint surrounded by subtle spice from integrated French oak barrel aging.

Robert Mondavi Private Selection Pinot Noir (California)

36.00

Lovely raspberry and dried cherry aromas mingle with complimentary scents of white and black pepper, mint and chicory.

Enroute Pinot Noir (Russian River Valley, California)

85.00

On the palate, the fruit is ripe and red raspberries, cherries and plums with spicy accents to give it depth.

Sanford Pinot Noir (Santa Rita Hills, California)

80.00

Underlying flavors of dark cocoa, Asian spice and a pleasantly smoky barrel essence. High notes of bright cherry-meets-boysenberry fruit.

Rutherford Hill Merlot (Napa Valley, California)

55.00

Beautiful deep red color is accompanied by aromas of black cherries, dark plums and boysenberries.

Mon Frere Cabernet (California)

35.00

A fruity palate with bold texture and a juicy mouthfeel.

Federalist Cabernet Sauvignon (California)

48.00

Small amounts of Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petite Syrah and Sangiovese round out a flavor profile that emphasizes blue and black fruits and a dash of cinnamon spice.

Unshackled Cabernet Sauvignon by Prisoner (California)

50.00

Featuring aromas of plum and blackberry with a hint of olive. Flavors of black stone fruit, cloves, dried herbs with solid tannin structure result in a flavor-forward wine balanced acidity.

Markham Cabernet Sauvignon (Napa)

60.00

Blackberry jam and cedar aromas are highlighted by intriguing notes of fresh tarragon.

Justin Cabernet Sauvignon (Paso Robles, California)

75.00

Aromatics with ripe black cherry and cassis with a full-bodied expression with dark fruits, vanilla, cinnamon spice offering a moderately long and fresh finish.

Prisoner Cabernet Sauvignon (Napa Valley, California)

85.00

Black cherry, vanilla and ripe plum on the nose rounded on the palate with Blackberry, cocoa, and baking spice with firm supple tannins.

Chimney Rock Cabernet Sauvignon (Stag's Leap District, Napa)

180.00

This wine is about elegance and finesse over power. Lush black cherry and cassis are balanced by hints of cocoa and vanilla.

<i>Ruffino Chianti Classico Riserva Ducale Tan (Italy)</i>	55.00
<i>A brilliant, ruby red color, sweet violet and iris aromas. Full-bodied and concentrated with hints of raspberry and anise.</i>

<i>An intense, rich bouquet of cherries, berries tobacco and violets with overtones of spice. Supple, elegant and harmonious.</i>

<i>Intense aromas of blackberries and ripe wild berries with fresh and lively frizzante style.</i>
